STAR TEST SUCCESS



Last week, on August 31, the California Department of Education released the results of the 2010-11 STAR test. As you know, we have been working diligently to surpass the 800 mark, barely missing it last year by just a few points. We are THRILLED to report that we not only met our goal, but surpassed it with an 18 point gain for school-wide score of 812 points!
